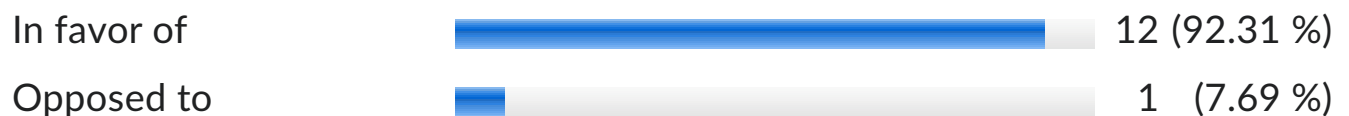
Question 5
